What should I do if I am concerned about my child's behavioral or mental health? (I live in Marion, Lake, Sumter, Citrus or Hernando County)



★ Starting Point is With My Child's Health Insurance Plan ★

DIAGNOSIS? Does my child need an evaluation to understand my child's behavior or mental health needs and to identify services that can help? ➔ **CONTACT** the child's health insurance plan and ask for **behavioral health coordination** or case management to help find providers and get linked to services for my child. **No insurance?** Call Lutheran Services FL: 877-229-9098

TREATMENT? Does my child already have a diagnosis and my child needs services? Or is my child receiving services and the services are not working or my child may need more intensive services? ➔ **CONNECT** with my child's pediatrician or psychiatrist for referrals for specialty evaluations and/or services and **Children with Medicaid** - ASK Health Plan for a referral for Targeted Case Management to help with getting services.

Is my child involved with other state agencies?

- Ask the agency representative if that agency offers any evaluations or services?

Alcohol abuse can have a devastating effect on the public, business and employees. Serving responsibly produces safer roads and neighborhoods, and a more profitable business.

The Responsible Vendor Training (RVT) class teaches employees, managers and owners of establishments that sell alcohol how to keep it out of the hands of minors and not sell alcohol to obviously intoxicated persons. By participating in the class, alcohol vendors will be equipped with the knowledge needed to avoid arrest, fines and jail time for alcohol violations. Additionally, businesses are eligible for a 10% discount on their insurance.

The intention of this training is to:

1. Eliminate the sale and service of alcoholic beverages to underage patrons.
2. Reduce alcohol related injuries and deaths.
3. Encourage prudent serving practices.
4. Promote professionalism and responsibility of staff.

Just as CPR helps you assist an individual having a heart attack – even if you have no clinical training – Mental Health First Aid helps you assist someone experiencing a mental health related crisis. In the Mental Health First Aid course, you learn risk factors and warning signs for mental health and addiction concerns, strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations, and where to turn for help.

Taught by two certified instructors, Mental Health First Aid teaches about [recovery](#) and [resiliency](#) – the belief that individuals experiencing these challenges can and do get better, and use their strengths to stay well.

Learn how to apply the Mental Health First Aid action plan in a variety of situations, including when someone is experiencing panic attacks, suicidal behaviors, acute psychosis or reaction to trauma. The opportunity to practice – through role plays, scenarios, and activities – makes it easier to apply these skills in a real-life situation. The **8 Hour Course Includes:** Workbook, Certificate of Certification.



"You're Not Alone" is our Project AWARE social media campaign to educate our youth in understanding that the words, "Mental Health" are not bad words and it is ok to ask for help. The focus of the campaign is to reduce the stigma on mental illness and provide suicide preventative measures by encouraging youth to reach out to talk to someone when experiencing feelings of sadness or stress. The program can be taught to the youth in a one 2- hour setting or broken down into a six- week course taught within classrooms, agencies or in community settings. Combined with Mental Health First Aid training for the community and You're Not Alone for the youth, the suicide preventive measures taught can assist the youth to reach out to not only help themselves but to help their peers and have the adults trained to assist the youth asking for help. By reaching the youth and the adults, the community together can reduce the stigma of mental illness and work towards suicide prevention.
